



HIV Testing Opt-Out

The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that HIV testing should be a part of routine healthcare. CIMA follows this advice. When you have your blood work done, a blood sample will also be collected for an HIV test. If you have questions about this test, please ask your medical assistant, midwife or doctor.

CIMA has made HIV testing a standard, routine test for our patients in order to provide the best possible care. The test tells us whether you have been infected with HIV.
